

Severe Allergy Guidelines
Model Lab School.

Because of life-threatening severe reactions that some of our students have to peanut and tree nut products, Model will follow these guidelines:

1. Model's cafeteria and grill will be "Peanut/Nut Safe" which means that no peanut or nut products will be served or used for cooking.
2. Model students, faculty, staff, ECU students, and volunteers will be asked to refrain from bringing any peanut/nut products to school in packed lunches, snacks, or for any events.
3. All faculty and staff will be trained annually in emergency procedures, including administering of EpiPen.
4. Locations of EpiPens will be made available to all faculty and staff, including substitute teachers, coaches, and others who work with the students.
5. Annual 504 meetings will be held with parents to develop appropriate plans for each individual student including the Food Allergy Action Plan. Parents will provide the "Permission Form for Prescribed Medication" which includes a physician's signature.
6. Teachers will follow the "Teacher's Checklist for Managing Food Allergies."
7. The greater Model community will be made aware that there are food allergies to be considered. Model events, concession stands, vending machines, etc. will use peanut/nut safe foods and cooking methods.
