We had numerous accomplishments including a State KHSAA and NASP/IBO World Outdoor Champion in the high school male division, NASP State Champion in the elementary female division, and high school team placing 11<sup>th</sup> out of 69 teams in the bullseye division and 9<sup>th</sup> out of 35 teams in the 3D division at the World Archery Tournament in Orlando, FL.

Sign-up Sheets for the Model Archery Team are located in the main office and next to the high school guidance office. This meeting is for parents and archers. In the meeting we will cover the new rules, discuss fundraising, complete paperwork, fit new archers for jerseys and check eye dominance, and take up orders for optional clothing.
